

# Lincoln Christmas Market



## Busking Code of Conduct



**The City of Lincoln Council have produced a Code of Conduct for Buskers at the Lincoln Christmas Market and we require all Buskers to abide by this Code.**

### **The Code of Conduct**

1. Noise (for example music or voice) should not be so loud that it can be plainly heard beyond the immediate audience.
2. We recommend that a 10 minute break is included within your allocated hourly slot.
3. You should not obstruct the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles on the highway (this includes pavements and pedestrianised areas), or allow an audience to do so.
4. Use should not be made of street furniture such as, lamp-posts, seats and bins.
5. Public Liability Insurance must be obtained. You are required to be skilled and experienced in using the props of your performance, and depending on the nature of your act, the Event Organiser may require you to complete a risk assessment.
6. Any Buskers taking part in the event under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult, and contact details must be provided within the expression of interest form.
7. An entertainer should immediately stop performing when required to do so by a council official or an emergency services representative.
